While the CSRRA is still retaining the silhouette of the men in their four-positions for the logo, the rules will be standardized by adopting NRA Smallbore Rules for the match (so no more guessing what the age requirements are or what the tie-breaking rules will be) and the time limit will be expanded to thirty (30) minutes to allow additional time for equipment adjusting and position changes. We are long past the days of walking into the range with a standard gun with few adjustments, cloth jacket, glove, kneeling roll, spotting scope, bullets, and a dollar for the entry fee. Alas, we now need a suitcase for our clothing, tool box for our tools and accessories, steel case with wheels for our gun, etc. So, send your entry in today, bring a friend—this match is open to everyone (from “first-time” shooters to “over-the-hill” shooters), and be a participant in the 1st year of the next 75 years of the “newer”, “more relaxed”, and “standardized set of rules” Gallery Match! Without your attendance, the 76th Anniversary will not be a success.

Rules: NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules will govern. Pay special attention to age requirements and tie-breaking rules. No pick-up teams allowed.

Course of Fire: Sub-Juniors: 20 Shots Prone, Iron Sights (coaching allowed)
Juniors: 5 shots each Prone, Sitting, Kneeling & Standing Iron Sights (coaching allowed)
Seniors: 5 shots each Prone, Sitting, Kneeling & Standing Any Sights (NO coaching)

Please remember that Sub-Juniors can fire in the Junior and Senior Matches, and Juniors can fire in the Senior Match.
