We would encourage your participation in this event and would appreciate if you could pass on this information to any other junior coaches, directors, club leaders or others interested in the sport of High Power shooting.

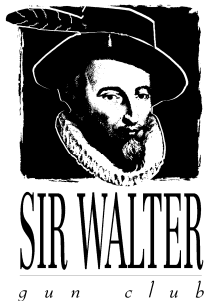

OPEN TO: Any competitor 12 -20 years of age or older and a citizen of the United States may enter this match. Juniors under the age of 12 who wish to compete must submit a request to the stats office for approval listing qualifications and experience.

ENTRY FEES: Included in daily registration fee - see registration form.

ENTRIES CLOSE: 10:00 PM. A LEG match card must be completed by all competitors before firing.

FIRING: 11:00 PM

RULES: Governed by the current CMP Competition Rules governing the National Trophy Rifle and Pistol Matches and Excellence-In-Competition (EIC) Matches as rewritten from AR 920.

Exceptions:

1. More than one competitor may use the same rifle if the tournament squadding permits. (6.5.3)
2. Distinguished personnel are permitted to compete for Place Awards only within range capacity with preference given not Non-Distinguished competitors.
3. Participation on a non-credit basis (practice) is prohibited.
4. Limited to Junior Shooters meeting the criteria under NRA/CMP Rules.
5. Open bolt indicators must be used.

COURSE: National Match Course (no sighting shots)

First Stage: Slow fire, 200 yards, SR target, 10 shots standing, 1 minute per shot. Sling must be on rifle and in parade position.

Second Stage: Sustained fire, 200 yards, SR target, 10 shots standing to sitting or kneeling, 60 seconds.

Third Stage: Sustained fire, 300 yards, SR-3 target, 10 shots standing to prone, 60 seconds.

Fourth Stage: Slow fire, 600 yards, MR-1 target, 20 shots prone, 1 minute per shot.

RIFLE AND AMMO:

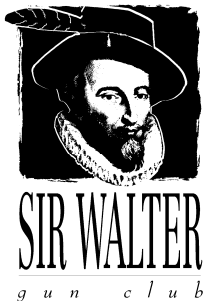
Competitors may use any of the following rifles in CMP sanctioned competitions: U.S. Rifle, Caliber .30, M1; U.S. Rifle, Caliber 7.62mm, M14; U.S. Rifle, Caliber 5.56mm, M16. (6.2). The requirements for those rifles are outlined in Civilian Marksmanship Program Competition Rules governing the National Trophy and Pistol Matches and Excellence-In-Competition (EIC) Matches. Triggers will be weighed.

Competitors must supply their own ammunition. Any safe .30-06, 7.62 and .223 ammunition will be allowed. Fifty rounds of ammo and any additional ammo as required for refires or malfunctions must be available.

AWARDS: “LEG” points will be awarded by the Director of Civilian Marksmanship (DCM). Appropriate Excellence-in-Competition badges will be awarded to Civilian competitors who qualify for same as provided by current CMP rules.

SQUADDING: Squadding will be available Thursday at 10:00 AM. Squadding not picked up 15 minutes before the match starts will be passed to the waiting list.

CONDITIONS:

- a. Squadding will be assigned by the Match Director. Each relay will complete the match before the next relay fires. See section 5A-1(g) for Team Pit Service requirements. All team members, firing and non-firing will be required to serve pit duty.
- b. Each team will provide a telescope of at least 20 power. See CMP rule 7.8 for use of the spotting scope.
- c. The only personnel allowed past the ready line at 600 yards are the firing members of the team, Team Captain, the Team Coach, the Team Score Verifier, the Assistant Range Officer assigned to the team, and 2 persons to police brass.

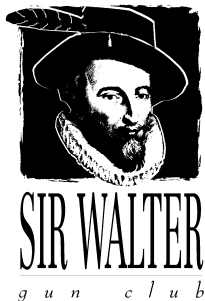
